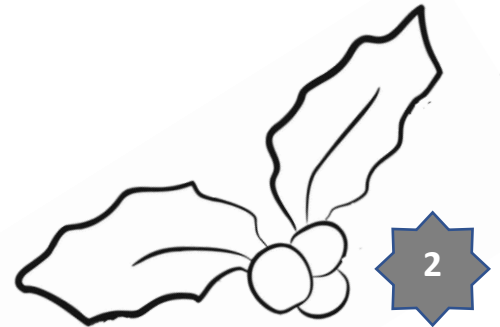


WELCOME TO THE LOVELL QUINTA ARBORETUM

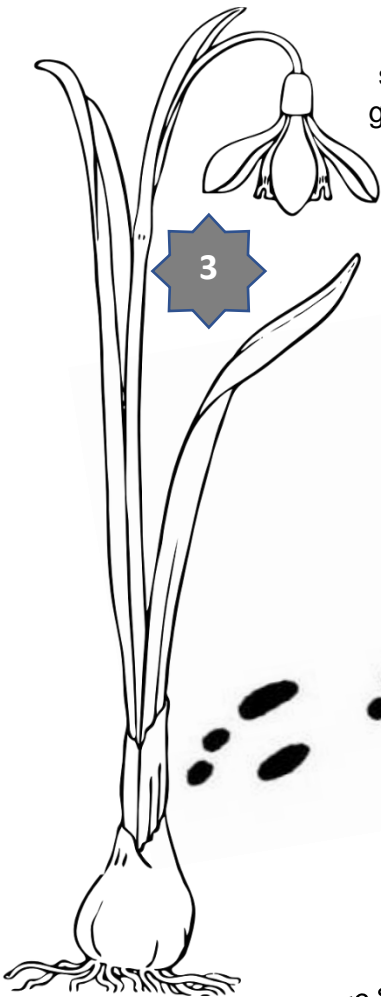
We hope you enjoy your visit with this free activity and colouring sheet



1 Which tree does the acorn come from? We have lots of these trees in the Arboretum – can you find any of them? HINT: look at the leaves on the ground!

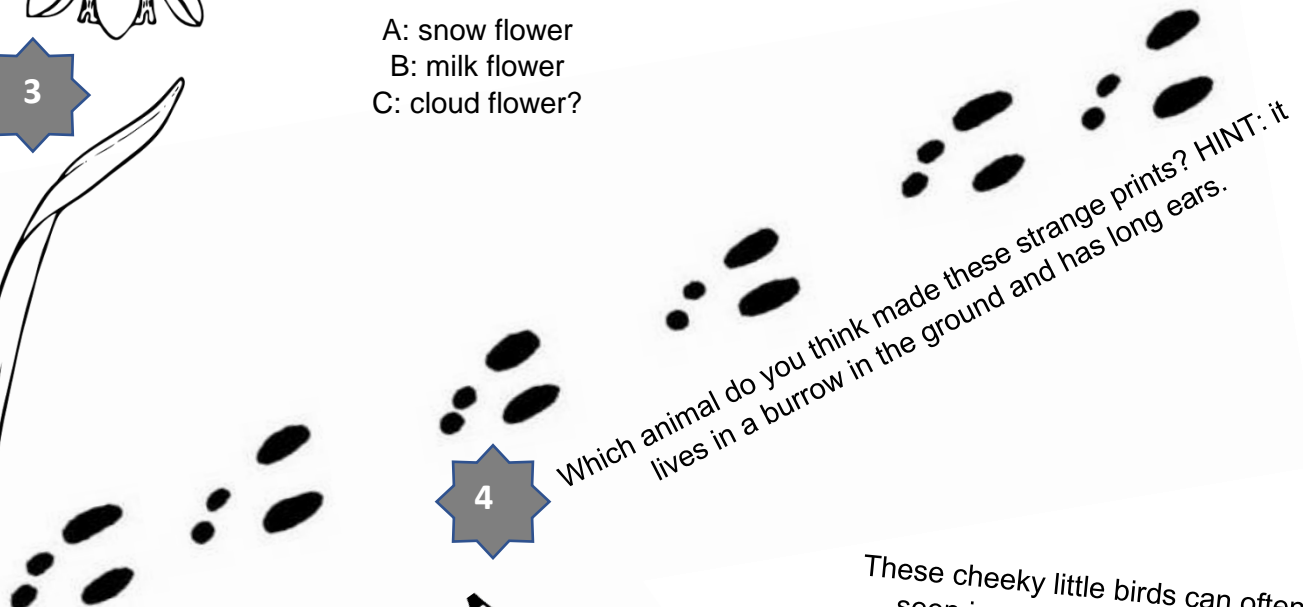


2 Do you know what these dark green, glossy leaves are called? Sometimes they have prickles, as well. Can you find any in the Arboretum?



3 These pretty white flowers are called snowdrops, you can find them by the main gate in January and February. Do you know what their name means in Greek? Is it:

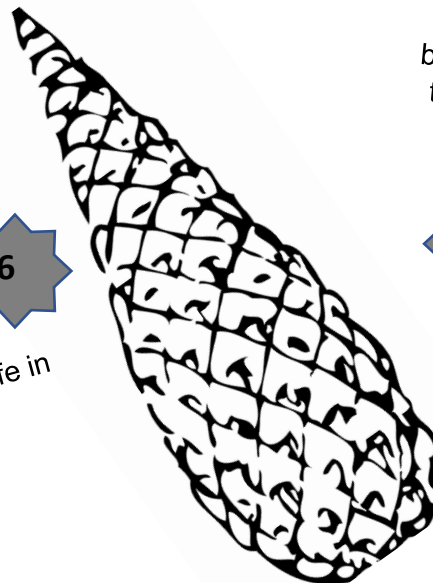
- A: snow flower

4 Which animal do you think made these strange prints? HINT: it lives in a burrow in the ground and has long ears.

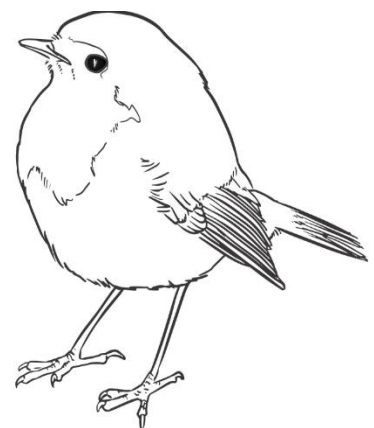
5 You might have seen pine cones on some of our trees, but do you know what they are for?
