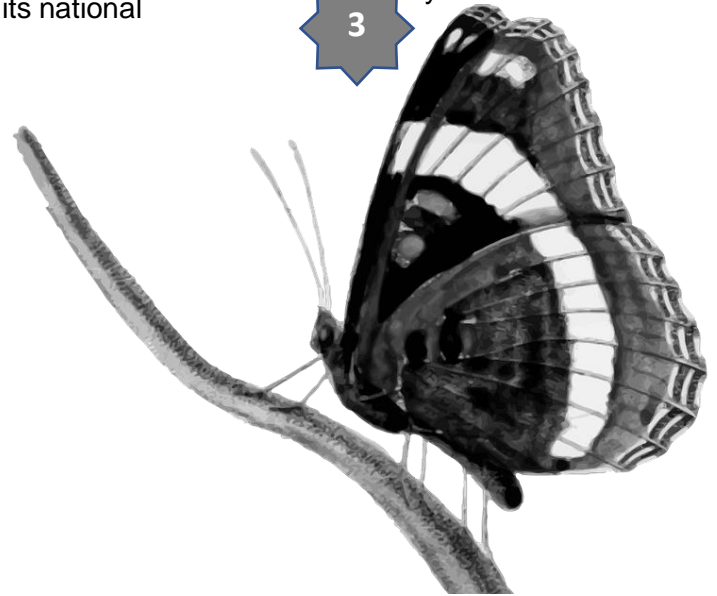

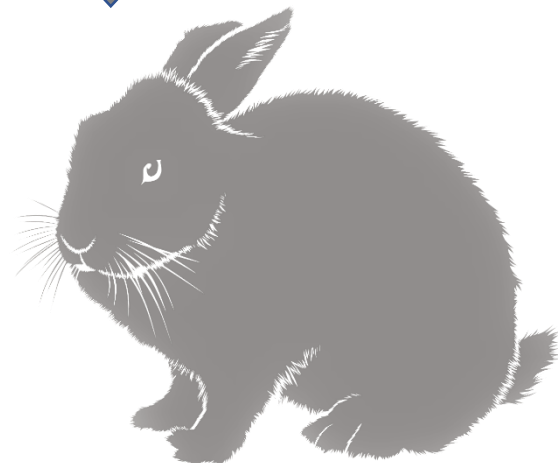
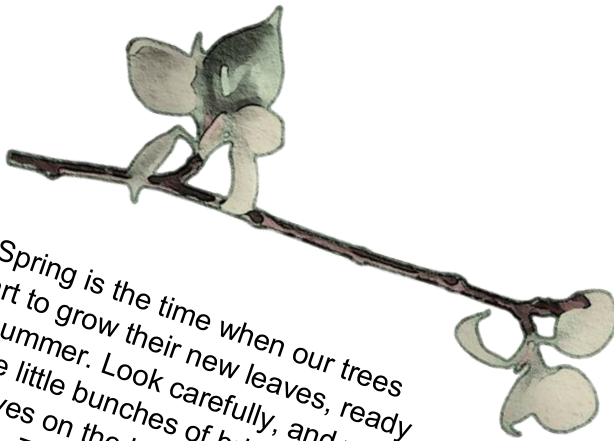
We have lots of wild rabbits in the Arboretum, and they start to get active in the spring. Do you know what type of homes rabbits prefer?
